In an effort to help support students as they plan for their future, we will implement a Guidance Program this fall that will allow 8th grade students to explore their abilities, career interests, and academic options.

The program is designed to introduce students to the Texas high school graduation plan (Foundation High School Program + Endorsement), explore career options related to each endorsement, and create a 4-Year Plan for high school that will support their college and career goals.

Program Components:

- Assessment to measure interests and abilities

- Course selection for 9th grade and development of a 4-Year Plan for high school
- Parent meeting to review student plans
